## 1890 BORDEAUX CHATEAU - RECONSTRUCTION NOTES



*Artist illustrations above show the Château if reassembled as originally built*

The Chateau stones are ready for export (near Bordeaux, France)

All pallets are audited and documented with CAD. A visit to the warehouse is by appointment.

- Time to build: 9352 Man Hours, 6-1/2 months to complete 4 finished facades
- How many people: 8
- Includes: 2 Master Stone Cutters and 6 Stone Masons
- Equipment: 2 Cranes
- Rhythm of Construction: 4 days to 1 week per row A - Z and I -VII (rows listed on CAD)
- Import from France: approximately 40 Containers of Stone
- Includes: All of the Chaux (Lime) to build the Chateau stone Facades
- Purchase from USA: Native Riverbed Sand #2 - which has a round texture - not jagged
- We will supply a plan of exactly how the pallets need to be placed for each row of construction
- We will mix the pigment for the joints (if needed)
- Estimated Cost to build the 4 stone Facades: See Reconstruction Estimate PDF
- The Seller confirms that all the stonework (i.e., pieces which in the aggregate collectively comprise the Item) has been carefully cataloged, photographed, illustrated, and uploaded into a CAD program (computer-aided design) program (the "Documentation").
- The Buyer acknowledges and agrees that normal wear and tear and minor damage to the component pieces of the Item is to be expected, since the pieces have been in-situ for about a century.
- The Seller is providing without charge to the Buyer, two additional containers of stone.
